OUR SESSIONS FOR KIDS



3RD - 6TH CLASS SESSIONS

- In-depth, interactive workshops designed to protect and empower children.
- Each session is targeted at an age group and focuses on equipping children with core digital literacy skills including navigating social media, messaging apps, gaming, how to protect personal data and their digital footprint, healthy balance, online reputation and cyberbullying.
- Children fill in a short, anonymous survey that enables us to understand **their** specific online usage and behaviours.
- The school receives a **full report** post-session.
- Sessions are suitable for 3rd 6th class pupils and limited to 35 pupils per session. Each session is approximately 40 minutes.

3RD CLASS - Engage

An introductory session preparing children beginning their online journeys.

4TH CLASS - Educate

Exploring key topics such as social media & gaming, and how to protect personal information.

5TH CLASS - Explore

Looking at how social media and advertising really works, misinformation and scams.

6TH CLASS - Empower

Empowering children by focusing on digital responsibility, including cyberbullying and managing digital footprint.

COMBINED CLASS SESSIONS

3RD & 4TH CLASS - Engage & Educate

This joint session combines the key learning objectives from the 3rd and 4th class sessions and is designed for smaller/mixed-age classes.

5TH & 6TH CLASS - Explore & Empower

This joint session combines the key learning objectives from the 5th and 6th class sessions and and is designed for smaller/mixed-age classes.

5TH & 6TH CLASS - Learning to be Literate Online

This session looks at how pupils can develop the increasingly important skill of Digital Media Literacy. This interactive session explores types of information online, targeted advertising, scams, digital well being, personal information and the importance of a positive digital footprint.
